- Small children are accepted provided they are clean.
- Parents (or legal guardians) must fill in an information form including a mobile number where they can be contacted before entrusting their child(ren).
- Both the clubs and EURONAT are naturist and their activity leaders will ensure that the rules are respected. Swimming costumes are obviously not permitted.
  - Children are not allowed to bring toys, games, valuables or money (except for mini-golf = €2)
  - Children should bring a bottle of water and, if necessary, a snack.
  - For the all-day and all-night activities, parents must provide a meal.
- Children must be punctual: if they are more than 15 minutes late, they will not be accepted for the activity.
- Children are not allowed to leave the club before the end of the activity (except in special cases discussed with the activity leaders).
- Parents authorise their child to move around the Euronat Centre and the Equestrian Centre at the entrance.
- Club staff are responsible for enforcing these rules. If necessary, the management reserves the right to modify all or part of the programmes and rules.

## And finally,
